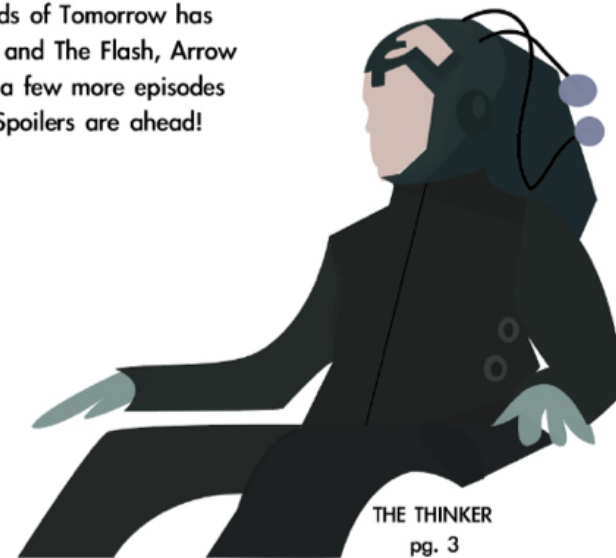

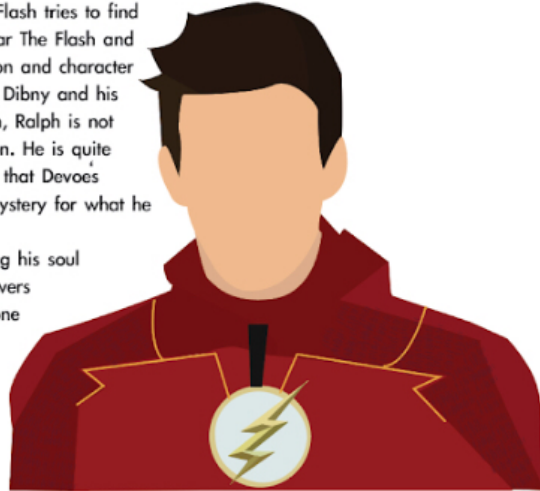
The Flash & Arrow Episode Reviews

The Flash Season 4 Episode 18 "Lose Yourself"

In the latest episode of The Flash, Team Flash tries to find another bus meta named Edwin Gauss. So far The Flash and Arrow have been lacking on story progression and character development. This episode centers on Ralph Dibny and his devotion to kill Clifford Devoe. In my opinion, Ralph is not really the best character The Flash brought on. He is quite annoying and he makes terrible jokes. I feel that Devoe's storyline is very interesting because it is a mystery for what he is going to do next. Spoilers!

After Devoe changed into Ralph by sucking his soul and killing him, we find out that Caitlin's powers disappeared. Currently, The Flash has not done anything about Caitlin's storyline. Caitlin has become a side character who is just there being a doctor. The only time when she is useful is when she turns into Killer Frost. Since she lost her powers, Caitlin is basically nothing to the team. As we are heading towards the season finale, little problems should not be appearing because the writers should focus on developing a plot that makes sense.

The audience still does not know what his back story is, which makes him a weak Arrow villain. Hopefully, as the story progresses, we get to know Dragon and his objective.



Meet Clifford Devoe (The Thinker)

His back story starts off on the night the STAR Labs particle accelerator exploded. The dark matter from the explosion gave him incredible mental powers. Since Devoe's powers require too much energy to maintain his body, he must find new metas to make himself turn into them. Not only does Devoe change into bodies, he absorbs the meta's powers. This makes it harder for Team Flash to find a way to defeat Devoe.

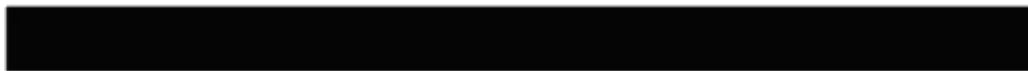
